The Bharatiya Temple Youth Camp 2015 Rules & Requirements
Applicant Requirements

1. Camper must be between the ages of 6 –13 as of 08/01/15
2. One form per camper is required. The form must be filled in its entirety.

Camp fee for Temple members is \$65/ per camper. Fee for each additional sibling is \$ 60.

Camp fee for a non-member camper is \$80/ per camper. Non-Member sibling cost is \$ 75.

Checks are payable to the **Bharatiya Temple** and payment must be **RECEIVED with the form.**

Failure to submit payment by due date will result in losing your spot and your name will be in the waiting list.

Camp Guidelines:

(Parents can keep this sheet - 3 at home for their reference)

1. Campers are required to check in on July 24th, 2015, no later than 6:00 PM. Campers shall not be dismissed until after the end of camp, i.e. 9 PM on July 25th, 2015. **Campers will not be allowed to leave in the middle of the camp.** Discipline must be maintained at all times. Continuous disregard of the rules and warnings will result in the camper's dismissal from the camp.
2. Smoking, consumption of alcohol or illegal substances is strictly prohibited. Anyone found violating this rule would be dismissed from the camp.
3. The use of the following is strictly prohibited: Cell phones, ipods, ipads or laptops. No cash or valuables please. No chewing gum will be permitted.
4. Campers are required to be present with the team assigned to them at all times.
5. Campers shall be considerate of others by maintaining a quiet atmosphere after 11 PM.
6. All team assignments for cleanups and setups must be completed per the request of adult organizers.
7. Every effort by every camper is required to keep temple premises clean. Campers are responsible for assigning their team set-ups/cleanups before & after every meal. Campers are responsible for cleaning up at the end of the camp.
8. For the well being of other campers, campers are requested not to attend camp if they are sick.
9. Parents / guardians will be contacted immediately and temporary medical attention will be given to a camper in the event of an emergency.
10. Instructions from the organizers must be followed at all times. **FAILURE TO COMPLY BY THE RULES CAN RESULT IN IMMEDIATE DISMISSAL OF THE CAMPER.**

Suggested Items for Campers

1. Sleeping bag, bed sheet, 2 blankets, pillow, toothbrush & paste, soap, hand towel, hairbrush or comb, socks, sneakers, under garments, 2 extra pair of clothes, swim wear/towel, water gun, sleep wear, (preferably long sleeved). **Please wear temple appropriate attire.**
2. Glasses/lenses case to store glasses/lenses at night. (If camper wears glasses/lenses)
3. Sun block cream, insect repellent cream and appropriate sets of clothing based on weather.
4. We plan to take pictures of all the campers on Friday evening with Camp T-Shirts
5. Talent Show costumes (**Counselor will contact you**)

Additional Information

1. Camp will begin promptly at **6:00 P.M. on Friday 7/24/2015 and end at 9PM on Saturday 07/25/2015.**
2. Campers will be provided meals and snacks during the entire camp period.
3. Campers are encouraged to bring items and materials they may want to use for the talent show and team posters (music, costumes, and markers). Counselors will call the campers during the week before the camp to provide more information.
